There are currently 46 recognised species of seahorse belonging to the genus (or family) Hippocampus (hippókampos). Seahorses were named so, as they have a head and neck similar to a horse. In Ancient Greek, hippo means “horse” and kámpos means “sea monster” or “sea animal”. Interestingly, in Greek, Hippopotamus stands for ‘river horse’.

Use this template to create species number 47. What if it had a mane like that of a real horse? Patterns like those you find on sea shells? Or spots like a cheetah? What if it’s tail was shaped like a flower?
