- Graduate of the Writing Picture Books Course, 2015, with the Australian Writers' Centre
- Shortlisted for the Speech Pathology Award 2019, *Hush Say the Stars*
- Mentor to fine artist, Ross Morgan, in the creation of his first picture book *Molly Moores Has a House Like Yours* (as the winner of the Raising Literacy Australia Author and Illustrator Mentoring Initiative - a program for emerging writers and illustrators living in South Australia)

Mandy's career to date has also included highlights such as being part of Phil Cummings - Stories Behind The Books exhibition with the State Library 2019, with artwork on display from *The Hip Hop Barn*; plus a special collaboration with Indigenous Artist, Susan Betts, for the children's book, *Warna Manda Baby Earth Walk*, published by Little Book Press, 2021. For this Mandy also played a mentorship role to Susan, guiding her through the process for her first picture book.

In addition, one of her most fulfilling roles, is to visit numerous schools each year, especially during Book Week, to inspire and share this passion for creativity and literacy with thousands of students.
